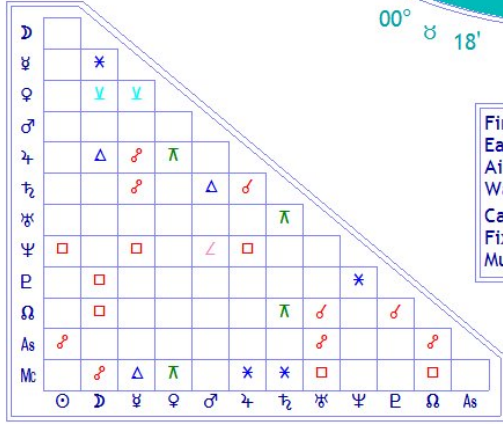
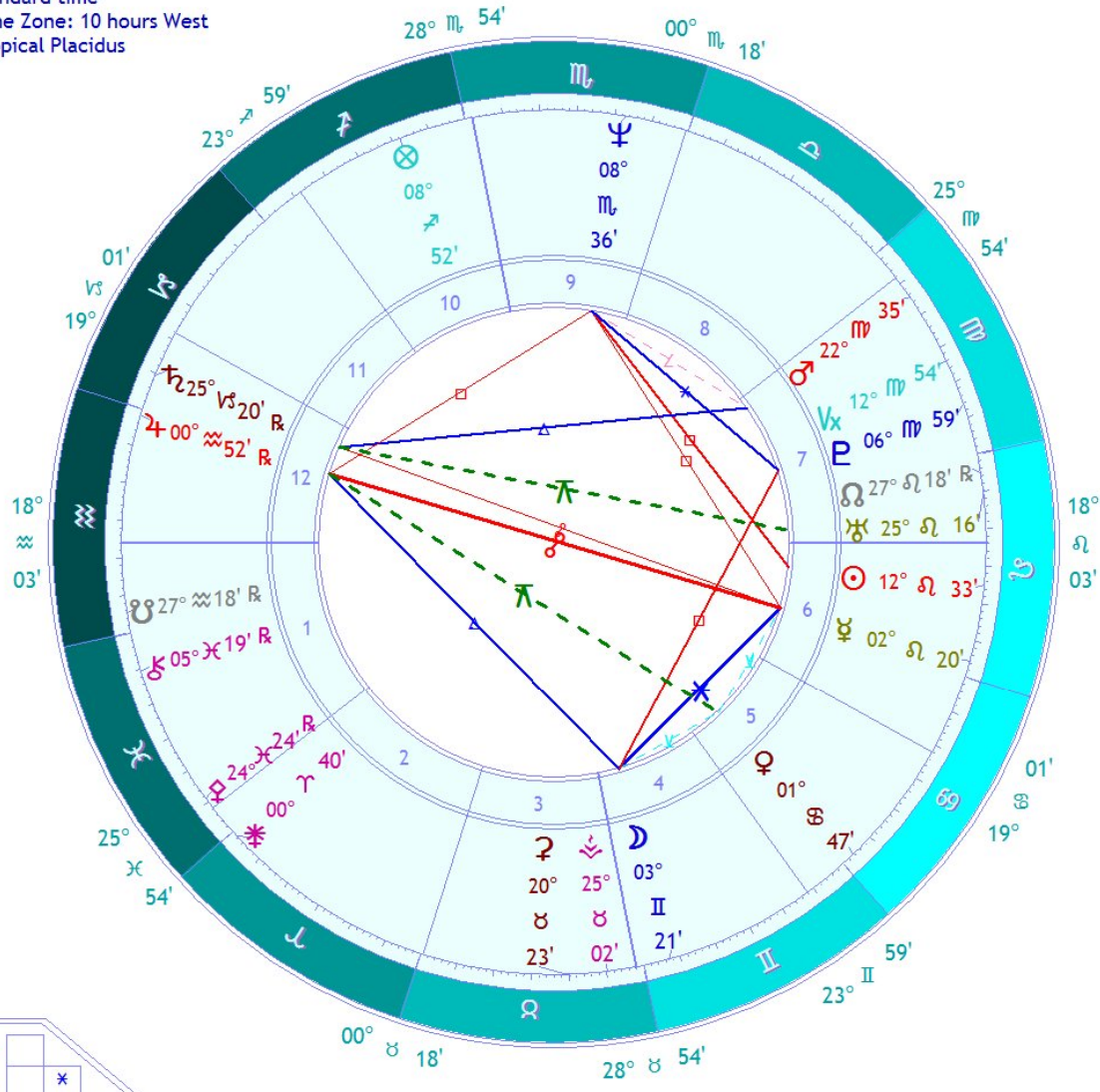
As a Rising Aquarius, your chart ruler is Uranus, the planet of innovation, futuristic thinking, and social equality. Some of your beliefs may be quite radical, which many people will find unacceptable. With a preponderance of fixed signs in your chart, you have a stubborn streak. Aquarius is the progressive thinker of the zodiac, but you can be more than a little self-righteousness in your notion of what's good for others.

That said, the placement of Uranus in the seventh house indicates that you can be very creative when it comes to forging partnerships. This is interesting, because people with a lot of fixed energy in their charts typically aren't good at compromising. However, it would appear that you do have this gift. Moreover, Uranus is very closely conjunct your lunar North Node, a destiny point in the chart. It would appear that your mission in this life is to build consensus while at the same time preserving your integrity and remaining true to your core values. There is such a thing as giving away too much. The trick here is to remain the strong leader that comes so naturally to Leo and yet to know when it is appropriate to defer to others.

Your Gemini Moon adds to your charm and ability to persuade through speech. Normally, a Gemini Moon can be emotionally somewhat shallow, but this is likely not the case for you, as your Moon is in the very emotional and moody fourth house. Again, I find this to be a good balance. You do have some sensitivity, but you don't make decisions based purely on emotions.

Saturn, the planet of structure (including social structure) and authority, is well-placed in Capricorn, his own sign, and he's at a favorable angle to action planet Mars. The difficulty I see here is not with Saturn's sign, but with his house placement and also the fact that he was retrograde when you were born. This suggests that you have some karmic baggage that needs to be resolved, probably to do with your father. Also, you may tend to repress your fears, perhaps due to your belief that fear is an obstacle to success. However, all fear is not bad. It warns us that we are in danger and in some cases can save our lives. The twelfth house is sometimes called the "house of undoing." Your biggest weakness could be ignoring real danger signs, thereby shooting yourself in the foot or worse.

Most people are familiar with their Sun sign, which is based on the month and day of birth. This is the sign we use as a reference point for newspaper and magazine horoscopes. But there are nine other planets that make their influence felt in your life, and they also were in a particular sign of the zodiac at the moment you were born. This report explores each of the planets in your chart in detail. If you provided a birth time, you'll also find information about your Rising sign, an extremely important element of your natal chart. If you don't know your birth time, we won't be able to calculate your Rising sign, but you'll still find a lot of useful information here.

This report takes into account the various spiritual and psychological implications, as well as your potential in this physical incarnation - we say "potential," because you have been given a certain amount of free will, and the life choices that you make will determine to a large extent the level at which these cosmic energies play themselves out. You might think of this report as your owner's manual or blueprint. Some sections will confirm what you already feel intuitively, while others may be completely new to you, unlocking the door for new life possibilities that you may not have considered. Mastering your life requires self-knowledge, and astrology is one of the best self-discovery tools available.

Your birth chart interpretation is based on the positions of the planets at the time of your birth. You'll find these positions and other technical information at the end of this report.



Chapter 1: The Ascendant

The precise time on the day of your birth determines your Ascendant, also known as your Rising sign. This was the zodiac sign that was on the eastern horizon at the moment you were born. In addition to your Sun and Moon sign, the Rising sign reveals very important traits that make up a major part of your personality and your approach to life. Your Rising sign represents your outer personality and image.

Aquarius Rising:

There is a distinct part of your outer personality that expresses itself very much like an Aquarius. You are friendly, somewhat unpredictable and you have the ability to maintain a sense of individuality even within the structure of a large group.

Since this was the sign of the zodiac that was rising over the horizon at your time of birth, the principle of Aquarius – unique self-expression – will be integrated into almost every area of life in some way.

Uranus is your chart ruler. To discover even more about what's a priority for you, and also the first impression you make on others, read everything in the chapter on Uranus.

Chapter 2: The Sun

The placement of the Sun in your chart will show you how (the sign) and in which area of life (the house) tremendous potential exists for you. Here is where you want to be successful. The Sun cannot be ignored. We must meet and deal with the area of life that the Sun shines on in our chart in order find ultimate fulfillment. Everything revolves around the Sun. When you master whatever issues the Sun points to, then other areas of life will proceed in a more balanced and satisfactory manner.

The Sun also represents your own will, major goals, the father, men in your life, children, creativity, and the real inner you.

Sun in Leo:

You are a born leader with a strong need for recognition. This sign is ruled by the Sun and as such, the limelight is a natural state of being for you even if this trait manifests simply as being recognized and applauded in some way for a particular talent or ability. You may not be a Leo who wants to actually be on the stage, but more likely than not, life experiences will put you in front of an audience of some kind; you may be a teacher, boss, head nurse, or boy scout leader to name a few examples. However, theatrics and acting do appeal to many Leos.



Being the dominant individual in any group is as natural for Leo as breathing. The universe gave you a special role and many of you feel that you may as well live up to it.

You are loyal, in love with love and ideally are in touch with the playful side of yourself. More is better as far as you're concerned and you can always be counted on to add color to any setting with your inherent ability to attract attention. Others may sometimes see you as flamboyant and perhaps even a bit vain. Who cares? There is nothing wrong with a healthy self respect as long as you don't forget that other people enjoy a little recognition also.

You can also be extremely opinionated and it's hard to knock you off your throne. Abdicating a fiercely held position is not your cup of tea.

Sun in 6th house:

Your personal fulfillment is reinforced by developing an attention to detail and learning all about the art of discernment. Often you will find yourself in situations which require creating some kind of order from chaos. Everyday responsibilities and the workplace are areas that will come into focus.

The Sun placed here will often emphasize anything related to the area of health, diet, and nutrition.

You could also find yourself in a position in which you are required to provide some kind of service for other people.

There is a side to you that can be something of a worrier. There are some underlying tendencies for perfectionism that can get in the way of letting go and just doing what you really want to do.

Neptune Conjunct or in hard aspect to Sun:

Your creative urges are stimulated by your imagination. However, the free expression of your will can be challenged by feelings of self doubt, making it necessary for you to avoid allowing yourself the luxury of self condemning thoughts. Stay away from negative modes of escapism (sleeping too much, drugs, etc.).

Trust inner voices that alert you to people, places and things that don't have your best interest at heart. To override this intuition is to invite disappointment and regrets. Observe the difference between true intuition and unrealistic fear.

Chapter 3: The Moon

The Moon in your chart represents the past and points to an area of life (the house) where we function out of instinctive awareness. Often we have a deep emotional need to do the things that the Moon's house placement represents. Whenever insecurities arise and our feelings become involved, we tend to bring the traits (the sign) of our Moon into play. The Moon is like our



security blanket.

The Moon also represents the home, women in your life, the mother, nurturing others or being nurtured ourselves, as well as things related to the domestic scene in general.

Moon in Gemini:

You probably have a higher need than most for mental stimulation and a variety of interests and things to do. You may find it difficult to sit still for long lengths of time, and you can wear yourself down burning up nervous energy. This can be a restless placement for the Moon. It makes you quite changeable, and very responsive to whatever is going on in the immediate environment.

A Gemini Moon is not generally known to be a depressed energy, but if you feel the blues setting in there is nothing like an interesting conversation or a good book to cheer you up and level you out again. Anything that gets your mind focused on learning or doing something new will lift your spirits.

Moon in 4th house:

You have an especially strong need for a secure home base and having a certain amount of privacy is probably very important to you. More than other people, you need a space to call your own. This placement of the Moon often indicates numerous changes of residence. If this is the case, then greater stability is obtained later in life.

You may also be fond of anything relating to the domestic scene. There can be a strong attachment to one or both parents and your upbringing had a strong bearing on your emotional security foundation.

Mercury in soft aspect to Moon:

You're sensitive, responsive, and versatile. People find it easy to share their thoughts with you because you're a good listener.

Any negative emotional states you find yourself immersed in can be countered through the use of thinking and logic. You can mentally talk yourself out of a bad mood. You are someone who can be appealed to through a logical mental approach.

Jupiter in soft aspect to Moon:

This aspect makes it easy to blow emotional states out of proportion. However, you will eventually bounce back because of an underlying optimism and buoyancy. You are generous and something of an idealist by nature. You can sleep off a bad mood.

Pluto Conjunct or in hard aspect to Moon:

Finding expression for your deepest emotions can be extremely difficult for you. Often you will simply choose to repress them until the unresolved issues surface again for acceptance and release. You'll benefit yourself greatly by finding an acceptable way to release emotional tension. You can drastically change your life by doing whatever it takes to heal, forgive, and release any old childhood issues.

Chapter 4: Mercury

Mercury is the planet of communication. It tells us about how we think and talk. You can gain insight into your mode of gathering, processing and transmitting information from Mercury's placement in your chart. Mercury also represents transportation, the five senses, youth, reading, and writing.

Mercury in Leo:

You are creative, outspoken and you speak from the heart. You know how to use the power of words to win the attention of your audience. Dramatic and often colorful self-expression is a talent employed by some Mercury in Leo people as a way of persuading other people to give them the undivided attention they desire.

Acceptance of opposing opinions may be difficult. Actually changing your own opinion about something could be nearly impossible. This placement is a plus for public speaking of any kind. You're probably a very good organizer too.

Mercury in 6th house:

This placement bestows you with excellent powers of logic and an ability to work with details. A variety of odd jobs can prevail until you're settled into a career. You may have a good eye for color and Mercury here supports the ability to use your hands creatively, such as making crafts, woodworking, sewing, etc.

Jupiter Conjunct or in hard aspect to Mercury:

You may experience an inner conflict at times between acting on logic and acting on pure faith. You express yourself well, but there is sometimes a tendency to be overly verbose due to the fact that you doubt your own ability to get your point across satisfactorily. People do understand more of what you say than you may think they do.

Really grasping what you hear can be challenging for you because your mind often likes to race ahead of the subject at hand.

Chapter 5: Venus

Venus is the planet of relating to others, and thus is associated with love, attraction and socializing. In a man's chart, Venus can provide clues about traits he finds attractive in women. In a woman's chart, it reveals something about how she relates to men. Venus is also the planet of material goodies and sensual delights in all of their various forms.

Other areas represented by Venus include money, harmonious conditions, pleasurable activities, beauty, and the arts.

Venus in Cancer:

A natural romantic, you are sentimental, charming and unselfish. This placement either makes you a mothering, nurturing partner, or it may work the other way around and make you long to be nurtured and cared for yourself. Hopefully, a balance can be obtained. Love equals security to you and you may often be imposed upon because others will sense your desire to please and attempt to take advantage of you. You may attract a partner who has some "growing up" to do in some regard.

Venus in Cancer people will never really forget a love affair or anyone else with whom there was a strong emotional attachment. The challenge here would be to let go of the past and move on when the time comes.

Venus in 5th house:

The odds are in your favor for happiness in love and your social life is enhanced. If you decide to express your creative side, this is well supported with Venus here. The positive expressions of your will in the sense of doing what you really want to do is also reinforced with Venus here.

You have a soft spot for children and even if the usual challenges arise in this regard, the scenario usually works out favorably in the end. If you have children, one of them may be involved in creative/artistic pursuits.

Chapter 6: Mars

Mars is our planet of action, energy output, motivation, and instinctive biological drives. It shows how and in which area of life you are willing to put forth a lot of effort. The energy of Mars is quick, impulsive, and survival oriented. In a man's chart, Mars reveals something about how he relates to women. In a woman's chart, Mars can provide clues about the traits she finds attractive in a man.

Mars also represents competitive situations, conflicts, accidents, and sexual energies.



Mars in Virgo:

With Mars in Virgo, you have a good amount of self discipline at your command. The planet of action in the sign of work combines to create conditions conducive to workaholism.

You can be a perfectionist and actions are systematically undertaken. There is a desire to be useful and you don't mind using your energy to help others. This placement supports the surgeon, craftsperson, and organizer.

Mars in 7th house:

You are willing to put a lot of time and energy into your marriage, best buddies, and other one-on-one relationships.

With Mars in the house of partnerships you can attract a mate who is energetic, passionate or perhaps a bit self centered. He or she is a survivor.

You may also have to deal with aggressive qualities in other people. Doing battle only begets battle and you can forget the doormat approach. Instead, practice integrating firmness and self honoring techniques into your strategy. Aggression will often back down when faced with an anchor of solid self-confidence.

Saturn in soft aspect to Mars:

This aspect helps you to focus your energy in a sustained and single-minded fashion allowing you to work diligently toward your goals. You don't waste your reserves of energy and physical endurance is strengthened.

Chapter 7: Jupiter

Jupiter is the planet of expansion and taking things beyond normal limits. It shows us where the universe allows us to indulge ourselves, and often we find that wherever it is in the chart is where things work out in our favor eventually. Some call this luck. Jupiter also represents faith, ideas about God, abstract thinking, high ideals, and abundance.

Jupiter in Aquarius:

You are self-sufficient, unconventional and cause oriented. You are tolerant of the many variations in humankind in general; however, once you form your own opinion about a particular subject you are hard pressed to change it. You will benefit by working cooperatively with groups of people devoted to a common cause.

Success in life is enhanced by having the courage to be different and by accepting your own unique qualities. There is a touch of rebelliousness in you and this can be positively channeled into humanitarian efforts.

You probably prefer to have numerous associations versus a few close relationships. Your life may also be marked by many circumstances that appear to be subject to sudden and unexpected changes. Generally though, these changes prove to be beneficial in the end. Flashes of sudden insight that seem to appear out of nowhere are really your own intuitive processes coming forth. Learn to follow the lead of these intuitive impulses and you will be able to maneuver through life changes with greater ease.

Jupiter in 12th house:

Whether you are aware of it or not, you have a kind of spiritual protection hovering around you. It's difficult for other people to succeed in undermining your goals. Eventually you will triumph. Spending some time alone and getting into a meditative state is beneficial for you. The potential exists for actual spiritual experiences.

You tend to expect the best and it's helpful for you to get into the habit of bringing yourself down to earth for a reality check once in a while, as other people won't always live up to your expectations.

Saturn Conjunct or in hard aspect to Jupiter:

Often you feel challenged to find a balance between letting your hair down and otherwise indulging yourself, versus doing what is considered proper and acceptable by traditional standards. Saturn, the planet of restraint, is urging you to create an equilibrium between these urges. Remember that you are being encouraged to find a balance, which doesn't mean you must eliminate joy, optimism and hope.

Trust your intuition and nurture faith and positive thinking. If you find that obstacles to the realization of goals always seem to pop up, then it's important for you to take an honest inner inventory of what you really believe you deserve. Immerse yourself in all activities that encourage self-esteem and positive thinking.

Jupiter is Retrograde

Your abundance is felt on the inside. You can feel satisfied with less than other people, which can be quite admirable in a way. The result is, it's easy for you to settle for crumbs when you'd really like more out of life. Take an honest inner inventory of what you believe you deserve, because that's what you'll get. Affirm to yourself that you can have what you want because you're worth it.

Chapter 8: Saturn

Saturn is our planet of restriction and discipline. It shows us where we may feel inadequate in some way, and thus we take this area of life very seriously because we want to perfect ourselves. Saturn also represents life lessons to be learned, trials and tests, a strong sense of duty, and



bringing ideas into material form.

Saturn in Capricorn:

You can be an extremely hard worker, and you'll overcome obstacles that other less dedicated souls would have given up on a long time ago. This is an excellent placement for successful achievement of goals. However, you will have to draw on your own ability to discipline yourself and persevere through difficult times.

Life lessons include learning to deal with authority figures and being responsible without necessarily being asked, especially for others.

You might also be willing to make tremendous personal sacrifices for the sake of your ambitions. Reminder: try not to lose sight of important relationships, and remember to take some time out once in a while to lighten up, otherwise you could end up lonely and dissatisfied. Bones, joints and especially the knees may be vulnerable to injury or arthritic type conditions. If these problems develop try avoiding caffeine and white sugar.

Saturn in 12th house:

This is a lifetime that will be greatly enriched by helping your fellow man altruistically. Make some time to add a little hope to someone else's life. You can empathize with others' feelings of hopelessness and despair because you have either experienced these emotions yourself or you have subconscious memories from past lives to draw on.

Develop conviction and learn to ignore inner voices of doubt and pessimism. Whatever you imagine can turn into reality, so you may as well make a pledge to yourself to think only the best. Take a chance on blind optimism.

Saturn is Retrograde

No one can give you a hard time like you can give yourself. You rarely feel satisfied with your own efforts. Constantly nagging inner voices of self criticism and unrealistic ideas of perfection can censor spontaneous creativity and squelch action before you even get started. You'll have to practice self trust. "Let go and let God" is a good mantra for you to mentally recite until your subconscious gets the message. Here's another: I will do my best and forget the rest. I will do my best and forget the rest. I will do my best and....

Chapter 9: Uranus

Uranus is a planet of unexpected change and unpredictable events. It tells us something about where we have unusual ideas and how we want to express our own unique individuality. Uranus also represents rebelliousness, sudden awakenings, invention, progress, genius, anything "New Age," and humanitarian efforts.



Uranus in Leo:

Uranus was in the sign of Leo for approximately seven years. This means that you are part of a large group of people who will share many of the same fundamental characteristics such as the ability to be highly creative and even flamboyant. Unusual approaches to child rearing and a rebellious attitude toward rules and regulations are keynotes here.

When you read your individual house placement for Uranus, you will be able to see where these traits will express themselves on a more personal basis.

Uranus in 7th house:

You can be a genius when it comes to partnerships. You have to be because you tend to attract partners who are quite independent, perhaps even a bit rebellious.

Close commitments may seem to be under the influence of many circumstances beyond your control. You or the other person might have some unusual ideas about marriage. Sudden attractions can tempt you to make legal commitments prematurely. Either you or your partner requires a certain amount of independence. Possessiveness can yield disastrous results.

Chapter 10: Neptune

Neptune is the planet that dissolves hard and fast boundaries. Where Neptune falls in your natal chart indicates where you may not want to see things as they really are, but would rather view the world through rose-colored glasses.

On the positive side, anything becomes a possibility with Neptune, especially that which we can imagine. Neptune also represents tuning into other planes of reality, the spiritual dimensions, cosmic consciousness, movies, music, and inspired creativity.

Neptune in Scorpio:

Because Neptune stays in the same sign about fourteen years, there are many other people who will experience the same things that this placement brings to varying degrees. Some of these include: a breakdown in sexual boundaries, positive spiritual transformation or extreme confusion along those lines, and a high level of deeply perceptive insights about yourself or others.

Your house position will show where Neptune affects your life on an individual basis.

Neptune in 9th house:

More than likely, your religious beliefs encompass a philosophy that is more universal in nature



than traditional orthodox dogmas. Your mind is ever searching for answers to the true nature of God and the workings of the universe.

There exists the possibility of some travel on the astral plane if that piques your curiosity. It's very important that the higher spiritual vibration of Neptune is used at all times.

Pluto in soft aspect to Neptune:

Bigotry and narrow thinking are huge turn offs for you. You lean toward a humanitarian outlook and you see the big picture, whether it applies to you or society as a whole. Mysticism, magic and the occult attract your interest and you can choose to use any knowledge gained to produce positive results.

Spirituality can undergo a complete regeneration process, and what went before will be transformed into something that doesn't even resemble the former. Usually there is a period of total chaos and confusion before order is restored.

Anything that is based on deception and pretense will be brought to light and purged accordingly. The effects of this aspect are often generational and the outcome will affect large segments of the society you live in.

Chapter 11: Pluto

Pluto is the planet of death, rebirth, and transformation. His position in your chart informs us about where you may go through a complete change at some point in your life or where deep, complex issues will be brought to light. It also tells us where your personal power lies. Pluto is about extremes -- it's all or nothing.

Pluto also represents psychological probing, keeping secrets or bringing them to light, power and control issues, obsessions, healing and purification.

Pluto in Virgo:

Pluto is the slowest moving planet, and thus is recognized as exerting a generational influence as it moves through each zodiac sign.

With Pluto in Virgo you're part of the generation that can experience radical changes in scientific discovery, the medical profession, diet and nutrition and the work ethic.

On a personal level, those with Pluto in Virgo tend to be aware of health related issues and are analytically minded, perfectionist and discerning.

Read the house placement for Pluto in your chart. It shows you an area of life where this planet has a more personal influence.

Pluto in 7th house:

You'll learn all about the art of cooperation with other people with this Pluto placement. One-on-one relationships, whether friends, marriage, or business partners, will affect your life in a profound manner.

Obsessive needs in the relationship department can cause you to pull in people who are controlling or manipulative. Power struggles only escalate the conflict. Once you decide that you can be your own best friend/advisor and you can walk away from "must win" scenarios, the universe will lighten up on you.

Chapter 12: Elements, the North Node, and the Midheaven

In this section of the report we interpret the following astrological influences: the Moon's North Node, the MC (the 10th house cusp or Midheaven) and also a preponderance of an astrological element. A "preponderance" occurs when four or more planets or the Ascendant are in that element: fire, earth, air, or water. Many people do not have a heavy emphasis of a particular element, so not everyone will have an interpretation of an element emphasis.

If the individual chart has aspects to the Midheaven, these will reveal certain career options and potentials for your consideration.

The North Node is an important pointer along the pathway of life.
